- (b) What virtues of the English King are mentioned in *Macbeth*?
- (c) What mirth and merriment does Gaveston plan to please King Edward II with?
- (d) How is Time treated in Spenser's One Day I Wrote her Name?
- (e) Comment on Milton's use of the Leviathan image in Paradise Lost Book I.
- (f) Write a note on any one of the following literary terms:

Soliloquy, Three Unities.

(a) "For never doted Jove on Ganymede So much as he on cursed Gaveston"

Who is the speaker? Whom does the speaker refer to here by 'he' and why?

- (b) How does King Edward II compare himself to Hylas and Gaveston to Hercules at the time of receiving his French minion?
- (c) What does Mortimer the Youmger signify in his device by the 'lofty cedar-tree' and 'a canker' under its bark?
- (d) How did Lightborn put an end to the life of King Edward II?
- (e) In what terms is Macbeth glorified as a hero in Act I of the drama Macbeth?
- (f) How does Banquo use the imagery of unfitting garment in describing the new honours received by Macbeth?
- (g) "I have done the deed."—Who has done the 'deed'? What 'deed' is referred to here?

- (m) What disaster does Ariel apprehend for Belinda?
- (n) Whom does Milton invoke at the outset of *Paradise*Lost Book I? Why does he invoke her?
- (o) How long did Satan and his crew take to fall from heaven? In which condition were they found in hell?
